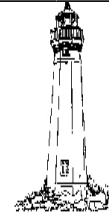

I Just Can't Wait!

The scene was one of excitement, anxiety and eager anticipation all across these United States on Friday morning, a day referred to as "Black Friday." As most know, stores offer heavily discounted merchandise for just a few short hours while the supplies last as incentive to get people in to spend money on these and other items in the store. Buyers get up early in the morning to assure their procurement of some of these discounted items for themselves, friends and family members.

That was also the plan for shoppers in Valley Stream, NY. Some customers arrived at the local Wal-Mart at 9:00 pm on Thursday night and waited for the 5:00 am moment on Friday to come. At 4:55 am the crowd of 2,000 could be held back no longer and made a mob-like entry into the store. Mr. Damour a 34 year old temporary employee was thrown onto the black tiles of the store and trampled. Despite the

fatal injury of Damour, the shoppers who were responsible continued their shopping and even refused to leave when the police asked, stating that they had been in line for hours and would leave when their shopping was complete.

Two things:

1. How unfortunate is the value some place on human life. For them it is less valuable than their time and even their bargain shopping (I am reminded of the priest and the Levite who walked by the injured Jew when the Samaritan did not).
2. How unfortunate is the fact that we do not have the same zeal for our faith and service to the Lord that these people had for their shopping! They had the "eye of the tiger!" They would not be stopped...get out of their way!

Let's do two things, (1) value human life and especially souls and (2) focus on the faith and service we must give!
