When the Shoe is on the Other Foot

Sitting in the dining room area of a hospice unit when I walked Obed. I had been up most of the night with my father, who had only a few hours left to live. I had spent the night praying, crying and talking with my unconscious Dad. I had stepped out of the room for a few minutes to gather myself when brother Obed entered the hospital. I cannot express how glad I was to see a brother in Christ, a familiar face.

Before this, I had been in nursing homes, hospitals, and the homes of brethren for the purpose of encouragement, but up until this visit I had no idea how helpful such gestures of kindness could be. In other words, until the shoe was on the other foot, I had no way of knowing how encouraging a simple visit can be. Here are some similar thoughts:

1. We may not recognize the importance of an encouraging word until the shoe is on the other foot. Elders, preachers, Bible class teachers and brethren need exhortation. We may

never understand how much until the shoe is on the other foot.

2. We may not understand the blessing of a visit until the shoe is on the other foot. When we see about the need of our brethren through a simple visit our gesture is also received by the Lord.

3. We may not understand the value of restoring the erring until the shoe is on the other foot. We may never understand the value of bringing back the wanderer until someone expends the energy to perhaps bring us (or our loved one) back.

4. We may not understand the sadness of missing worship until the shoe is on the other foot. Some of us may never appreciate the beauty of worship and the pain of missing until the shoe is on the other foot.
