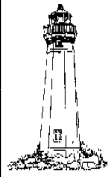
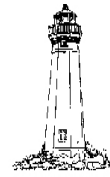

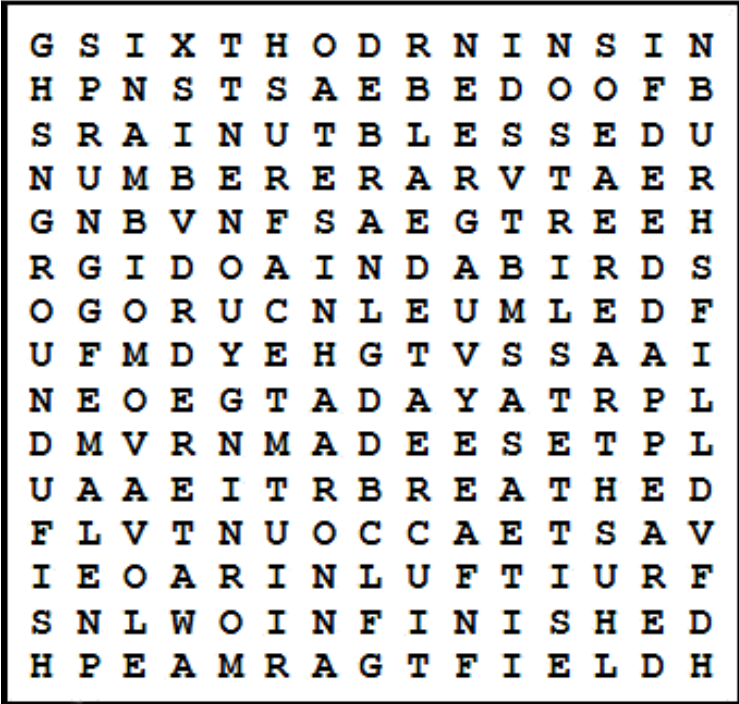

Snatch Them From The Fire

There is amazing imagery in the Bible! Jude discusses saving others by "snatching them out of the fire." This is a very interesting command given some of our attitudes toward evangelism.

Sure there are a number of ways to evangelize (i.e. friendship evangelism, preaching, debate, beneficence, giving, etc.) however, are we truly doing all that we can to snatch some from the fire? Paul writes of making the Jews jealous in order to save them (Romans 11.13-14); Timothy was to watch closely himself and the teaching that he gave in order to save others (1Timothy 4.16); what can we do to save others?

No doubt, when Jude writes about the fire he is metaphorically describing judgment that results in condemnation in hell, but consider the snatching Jude writes of. The word here implies something sudden (BDAG, ἀπνάζω)

and with force (Louw-Nida, 18.4) and can be understood from some of the other places it is used (i.e. Matthew 13.19 of the devil stealing the sown Word from hearts, the Greek translation of Judges 21.21 of desperate men taking women to be their wives, John 6.15 of the people wanting to take Jesus and make him their king). How are we snatching people from the fire?

There are a number of opportunities if we will only take them. Use the tracts in the foyer; use the "Searching for Truth" DVD's and books, use the Jule-Miller filmstrips, invite them to fellowship meals, invite them to our Bring-A-Friend Day on April 26. There is no way you can stand before God and say that you had no opportunities...you'd better take time and initiative to save a soul, for their sake and for yours!
