Where is the "Easy Button?"

If you watch any amount of television you most likely have seen advertisements that include the "easy button." This is a fictional button that will make any task easy. In many circumstances most of us would like that old "easy button." Try doing anything big and you will see how difficult things can be.

If you are buying a house, you must navigate through all of the things that are needed to get the home mortgage while also directing everyone to do their part. The pest control person must arrive at these times and be responsible for this with your paying such and such a price. The appraiser must do this and that. The closing attorney must do this and that. The surveyor, the inspector, the seller, the buyer, the county, etc. all have responsibilities.

If you are opening a restaurant or eatery, you must have health and building inspections, interview to hire employees, advertise to get customers, buy equipment, find and solicit food suppliers, decide what food to serve and

what it will be served on or in, and the list continues.

If you are preparing your child to enter school for the first time, you must have and demonstrate proof that they have been immunized, purchase their pens and paper and backpack, teach them proper behavior while at school and away from you, and the list goes on.

Compare those things and others to obeying the Gospel. You really don't need an "easy button" to do it. It is already easy! When asked what they were to do Peter told those at Pentecost very succinctly in Acts 2.38, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins." This is what you do if you believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and are willing to confess that before others. Have you done that? Are you willing to? Don't wait...do it as soon as you can!
